Prosthodontic Protocols and Prerequisites in Modification of the Occlusal Vertical Dimension



With an aging population, there is an increase in the number of patients who want to retain teeth for life. Quality of life is also very important to these patients. Unfortunately, many of these patients have been heavily restored and have lost occlusal vertical dimension (OVD) and often have a collapsed dentition with limited intermaxillary space for restoration. For such patients understanding the protocols and phasing of treatment to enable an increase in the OVD and a reorganisation of the occlusion is important. Not all clinicians will feel comfortable with undertaking such treatment but an understanding of the process is none-the-less of benefit when examining and consulting with such patients.

The attendee will:

- understand the reasons for increasing the occlusal vertical dimension.
- learn protocols for undertaking this task and what are some of the pitfalls.
- learn how phased treatment is used to provide a successful outcome.

Gilbert Watson graduated in 1984 with a BDS from the University of Otago. He then spent 14 years in private practice before returning to Otago to complete a 3-year Prosthodontic Masters. On returning to Auckland he established a specialist private practice and has recently completed two-year tenure as the President of the New Zealand Academy of Prosthodontists and Restorative Dentists.

Clinical Therapeutic Strategies for the Prophylactic and Active Intervention of Salivary Hypofunction: A Modern Perspective



Dry mouth is a common problem, with many causes. It causes many symptoms including difficulty eating, communicating, a burning sensation or bad taste and it frequently gives rise to dental disease, oral mucosal infections and salivary gland disorders. This lecture will review the causes, detection, complications and management strategies of salivary hypofunction.

Delegates will be able to:

- have an appreciation of the many diverse causes of reduced salivary flow.
- detect and investigate for possible underlying causes of dry mouth.
- develop strategies to reduce the likelihood of complications of salivary hypofunction and to provide good symptomatic relief.
- understand patients' concerns in relation to management of chronic disease and be able to provide supportive care.

Anita is an Oral Medicine Specialist and Professor of Oral Medicine at AUT University, Department of Oral Health. She qualified first as a doctor and later as a dentist. She completed her Oral Medicine specialist training at the Eastman Dental Institute, London. She and her family moved to New Zealand in 2009. Her research interests include the genetic and prognostic significance of oral lesions in Crohn's Disease, salivary gland disease and the impact of vitamin D on oral health.

How to Distinguish your Dental Practice from the Rest to Stay Innovative and Relevant in a Competitive Environment

The business cycle ebbs and flows with time and despite experience, as do the instances of failure and success. I will divulge the many lessons that I have learned from a disadvantaged angle, and explore strategies of how to develop a business plan and execute this via the implementation of basic concepts. There are cornerstones of business that must not be violated.

Delegates will learn how to be architects of their success by negotiating common hurdles and fostering an environment conducive to positive growth for the entire team.

- How do we know what price point to use for success?
- Should we be service or volume based as a result?
- What's the catch? Is it really just about the bottom line?
- How can we use profit to generate even more growth in cost-effective, time-proven strategies?

In 1986 Garth completed a Dip. Management diploma from ANZIM (Christchurch) followed by his DipBusOps from the University of Auckland in 1994. Garth spent 13 years in the pharmaceutical industry at home and the UK before returning to NZ and forming a joint venture in the dental supply industry. In a career exceeding 35 years, he has held senior positions in sales, marketing, distribution and finance. From 1993 – 2016 he was Managing Director of Henry Schein Inc.

Pink and White Smile Aesthetics

The presentation aims to address the components of a smile that contribute to dental aesthetics. A discussion on the biological variables involved in smile aesthetics along with an overview of landmark literature that has contributed to our current understanding will be undertaken. Clinical cases will also be presented, highlighting the importance of a multi-disciplinary, evidence-based approach to providing excellent clinical outcomes.

Attendees will:

- understand the principles of smile aesthetics.
- appreciate the biological complexity of the oro-facial complex.
- identify cases that would benefit from specialist referral or a multi-disciplinary treatment approach.
- be introduced to key landmark literature that has shaped our current everyday clinical practice.
- understand the importance of a patient-centred treatment approach.

Mohamad is a locally trained Orthodontic specialist who qualified from the University of Otago and practices at Shakespeare Orthodontics in Auckland. Mo has presented at national and international conferences/meetings including presentations at the International Association of Dental Research (IADR), the European Orthodontic Society, and the Australasian Begg Society of Orthodontics conferences.

He is affiliated with the Royal College of Surgeons (Edinburgh) and the Royal Australasian College of Dental Surgeons (Sydney) and has numerous national and international memberships including a Fellow of the World Federation of Orthodontics, the New Zealand Association of Orthodontists and the American Association of Orthodontists.

Strategies to Create Better Emergence Profiles-in Pursuit of the Elusive!

Osseointegration was once viewed as the final frontier in the quest to ensure that the dental implant was a credible clinical alternative to use to replace the human tooth. Having achieved that goal with predictability, clinicians became very aware that soft tissue was an entirely different issue.

Our improved understanding of tissue biotypes and the evolution of clinical techniques have specifically targeted improved soft tissue outcomes that have however helped considerably.

We now have several options to address soft tissue situations that are less than optimal. The key however is to be able to strategise effectively, as choosing the right clinical option is extremely important to final outcome.

What options do we currently have available? This presentation will address some of the simpler options available and attempt to provide a roadmap for effective clinical decision making. The goal will be to ensure that we effectively take soft tissue profile into account early and understand how and when we act to get what our patients ultimately want: a functional and aesthetic implant restoration.

Attendees will be able to

- understand some of the options that exists to ensure a good soft tissue emergence profile.
- understand how to make choices and choose the right clinical option or technique.
- recognise soft tissue challenges in advance and sequence clinical intervention appropriately.

Dr Nitish Surathu is a former Associate Professor of Periodontics who currently practices general dentistry in Gisborne. He completed his BDS in 1991 and went on to complete a MDS in Periodontics in 1994.

He is, by examination, an accredited Associate Fellow of the American Academy of Implant Dentistry and is also a Fellow and Diplomate of the International Congress of Oral Implantologists. He has lectured around the world on periodontics and dental implants and continues to be actively involved with hands on courses.

Dr Surathu served on the Executive Council of the Asian Pacific Society of Periodontology for over a decade and is currently a Director with the ACE Institute.
