The Use of Invisalign in Restorative Situations in General Practice

He is a member of the Align Technology APAC GP Academic Advisory Board and has published a number of Clinical White papers about Invisalign treatment.

Aesthetic Ceramics

This lecture will focus on useful techniques to achieve aesthetic beauty in a predictable protocol using the latest all-ceramic materials. A review of ceramic framework selection will prove as the critical foundation to determining the final outcome. In many cases, the use of digital technology will be demonstrated as a modality to achieve accuracy, efficiency and predictability in both simple and complex cases. Its place in the modern ceramic workflow will be showcased.

The attendee will

- learn the various framework materials and designs to be utilised for modern anterior all-ceramic restorations.
- learn the why, where and how much about cutback techniques prior to micro layering ceramics.
- review the importance of stump shade communication and how this can be integrated into the ceramic building workflow to ensure the best chance of a best result.
- learn the basics of designing cases ranging from simple to complex using digital technology.
- learn how to differentiate which materials will perform more optimally in which situations.

In 2004 Shinichiro graduated from dental technical school in Kyoto, Japan, and registered as a dental technician. He completed his post graduate course in 2005, and worked at a dental laboratory in Japan until 2007. Shin immigrated to NZ in 2007 and began working at the Newmarket Dental Studio as a registered dental technician. Shin is the master ceramist behind the case which achieved the Ivoclar e-max Smile Award 2016 Top 10 ranking completed together with Clarence Tam.

Soft Tissue Matters – Harmonising the White and Pink



Dental aesthetics is not only determined by restoration/ tooth shape but also by the soft tissue. In this presentation, we will look at different types of cosmetic periodontal surgery that can enhance the aesthetic outcome.

The following procedures will be covered in the presentation:

- Gingival augmentation including free gingival graft and connective tissue graft.
- Implant aesthetics: Connective tissue and bone grafting + Importance of correct emergence profile.
- Ridge preservation following tooth extraction.
- Crown lengthening surgery including gingivectomy and apically repositioned flap + osseous recontouring.

The attendee will learn

- what periodontists can advise on aesthetic dental treatment
- how to select the right cases for the soft tissue procedures
- how to choose right implant fixture and abutment design
- biological principle of socket healing and how to perform ridge preservation correctly.

David Ko is a Periodontist who specialises in implant dentistry and periodontology. He has completed his undergraduate program at Otago University in 2010 and worked as a general dentist before returning to Dunedin for postgraduate doctoral training in Periodontology in 2013. After gaining the specialist degree, he worked for two years in Auckland and moved down to sunny Hawke's Bay. He offers a wide range of gum and soft tissue related treatments including dental implants, gum grafting, sinus lifting, and periodontal disease treatment.

Ultimate Aesthetics: What Most Doctors are Not Doing, and Why it Makes all the Difference!

Among the various disciplines in dentistry, there currently is not a formal recognised specialty in cosmetic dentistry. As such, any doctor can advertise themselves as "cosmetic dentists". However, this IS changing, and it likely will not be far off where we will see it formally recognised as its own specialty with clearly outlined standards. Two recognised accredited members of the American Academy of Cosmetic Dentistry will discuss what they have learned on their clinical journey through Accreditation, and reveal what they have discovered as those clinical "must-do's" that make all the difference in attaining the highest recognised standard in responsible cosmetic dentistry.

Attendees will be exposed to, by observing clinical accreditation cases and their related stories, all of the "must-do's" for developing an eye for and the technical skills necessary to offer and achieve a high level of cosmetic dentistry for their patients.

Overarching principles as well as clinical tips and techniques will be discussed as they relate to the five specific case types:

- 1.) Six or more anterior indirect ceramic restorations
- 2.) One or two anterior indirect ceramic restorations
- 3.) Replacing an anterior tooth with an implant or bridge
- 4.) The anterior direct resin class V
- 5.) Six or more anterior direct resin veneers.

Any doctor wishing to enhance their knowledge of and skill for cosmetic dentistry will find attending this presentation a "must-do"!

Dr Marshall Hanson is a member of the New Zealand Academy of Cosmetic Dentistry and an Accredited Fellow Member of the American Academy of Cosmetic Dentistry.

His clinical work has been published in various peer reviewed journals, nationally and internationally, with a focus on new technologies and responsible aesthetics.

He graduated with Honors from the University of the Pacific Arthur A. Dugoni School of Dentistry (UOP) in 2007, and currently works at Villa Dental in Hamilton, New Zealand.
