Dr Gilbert Watson

Gilbert graduated in 1984 with a BD from University of Otago. He then spent 14 years in private practice before returning

to Otago to complete a 3-year Prosthodontic Masters. As part of his MDS he completed research based on the maintenance involved with implant overdentures having two papers published in peer reviewed international journal - The International Journal of Prosthodontics. On returning to Auckland he established a specialist private prosthodontic practice and became editor of the Auckland Dental Association newsletter as well as facilitator for the New Graduate Programme. He has lectured for different organizations throughout Australia and New Zealand including the New Zealand Academy of Cosmetic Dentistry, the Auckland Dental Association and Biomet 3i having completed over 70 lectures since 2011. He has also recently completed a two-year tenure as the President of the New Zealand Academy of Prosthodontists and Restorative Dentists.
