**Tips and Tricks for Invisible Class IV,
Class V Restorations, Incisal Troughing and
the Direct Resin Bonding Concept.**

SYNOPSIS:

Content will focus on bonding fundamental tips and tricks that the practitioner will be able to bring back to the surgery on Monday morning. The concept of location-driven material selection will be key in optimising both function and aesthetic aspects of the planned restoration. Techniques ranging from case planning and selection, layer placement protocol for blockout of join lines and incorporation of incisal detail will be discussed. Finishing and polishing protocols will be reviewed.

LECTURE OBJECTIVES:

1. The attendee will learn the fundamentals of preparation design as pertains to achieving Class IV and V success.
2. The attendee will learn the differences in material features as pertains to their use in various layers of the invisible Class IV and V restorations.
3. The attendee will learn the placement protocol and identify caveats in treatment along with solutions to overcome them.
4. The attendee will learn a proven troughing technique to reinforce and restore incisal erosive lesions predictably.
5. The attendee will learn the armamentarium required to finish and polish these restorations for minimal plaque retention and maximal long-term aesthetics.

Dr Bud Mopper is in private practice in Glenview, Illinois, where he has been doing minimally invasive dentistry with composite for almost 40 years. He is an internationally renowned lecturer in esthetic dentistry with an emphasis on composite bonding using direct application techniques. He co-authored, A Complete Guide to Dental Bonding, which was the first definitive book for the dental profession describing bonding techniques.

He is a member of the Academy of Esthetic Dentistry, Fellow of the American Academy of Cosmetic Dentistry, Diplomat of the American Board of Pediatric Dentistry, and Fellow of the American College of Dentistry. He teaches direct resin bonding on a continuing education level at many major universities including the University of Iowa and the University of Illinois.

Dr Mopper is the recipient of two of the most prestigious awards given by the American Academy of Cosmetic Dentistry. One for "Lifelong Commitment to Providing Excellence in Continuing Education in Cosmetic Dentistry" and second, an award for "Outstanding Contribution to Cosmetic Dentistry." He received New York University College of Dentistry's "The Irwin Smigel Prize in Esthetic Dentistry," and recently received the "Lifetime Achievement Award" from the World Aesthetic Congress in England for his outstanding contribution to cosmetic dentistry.

Dr. Mopper is Director of Education for the Center for Esthetic Excellence, in Chicago, IL, and is Co-Founder and Chairman of Cosmedent, Inc.
