Mr Steve Shepherd

Steve completed his BSc (Hons) in Biochemistry in 1984 from Otago and received a scholarship from Gene Stock NZ to study a PhD (in-completed) in Immunobiology Dept under Prof James Watson. In 1989 Steve moved to the UK to work initially with Septodont, developing training in Dental Anaesthesia in Endodontics. Much of this time was devoted to developing skillsbased training in Endodontics. Developing courses with Key Endodontists (With Analytic Company – original developer of the EPT) in the UK and Europe as well as development of Endodontic Surgical DVD training courses. Attending many major Endodontic meetings around the world for the past 20 years and working with many major Universities and Research institutions developing research into Endo File development and root canal sealers. Having setup Endo training in most of Asia for the past 15 years and working with some of the great researchers around the world -Steve has some interesting perspectives on what the endodontics 'success' looks like.

TOPIC:

VITAL PULP THERAPY PULP CAPPING: CONSERVING THE DENTAL PULP — CAN IT BE DONE? IS IT WORTH IT?

Synopsis:

- **1.** Regenerative procedures should be considered the first line of management.
- **2.** Vital pulp therapy using Calcium Silicate, Materials is highly successful Clinically and Radiographically in inflamed permanent teeth with carious exposure and in dental Trauma.
- **3.** Vital pulp therapy following the guidelines proposed has the potential to improve the outcome of the conservative treatment of mature teeth with deep caries and in some occasions may be an alternative to <u>pulpectomy</u>.
- **4.** The choice of conservative vital pulp therapy or root canal treatment for deeply carious teeth remains a matter of clinical judgment (14). To refine that judgment, I will present the reliability of common clinical findings in diagnosing the present health status of the dental pulp. The methods for the diagnosis of pulp conditions are still very limited in terms of accuracy the clinician has to collect data from subjective examination (chief complaint and dental history), visual inspection, radiographic examination, and response to stimuli application (pulp tests) and then infer the possible diagnosis.
