Composite resin used artistically with dialled-in occlusion allows placement in areas of application never dreamt possible. Learn how to push the limits using these modern super composites in a step-by-step, design-guided manner. Understand the proper way to prepare enamel and dentin surfaces for maximal bond strength using modern agents. Are they all created equal? Zirconia - is it a panacea, and how the heck do we bond this?
